STA's vision: to set the standards and be the benchmark for what people expect and demand from an International Tennis Academy.


STA's philosophy: we care about Player Welfare, Player Development and our Player Pathway. We look after our players from day one all the way through their journey.


STA's Performance Team works closely with the Off-Court Team to ensure the Academy runs smoothly day-to-day and reaches its bigger picture goals.

The Role

This role includes, but is not limited to:

- Collaborating with tennis coaches using objective data to enhance player performance.
- Supporting player communication and welfare.
- Tagging STA players' matches using Dartfish.
- Gaining a solid understanding of Dartfish and confidently educating coaches, players, and parents on how to use the software.
- Generating statistical reports using Power BI.
- Presenting insights to coaches through a combination of Dartfish and Power BI.
- Learning, maintaining, and further developing existing automated statistical reports in Excel, Power BI, and Dartfish.
- Building and maintaining a baseline statistics database across all age groups within the academy.
- Assisting in the creation of presentations for parents to explain the role of performance analysis in their child's development.
- Filming matches at the academy's weekly Friday Matchplay sessions.
- Supporting local and national tournaments by filming matches for Full-Time Players.
- Contributing to content collection during training sessions and building a video/photo library across age groups.
- Working with STA's Marketing Team to produce social media content and visual assets related to performance analysis.
- Communicating with players, parents, and sponsors - in person and via phone/email regarding performance analysis-related questions or updates.
- Demonstrating flexibility and initiative in day-today responsibilities.

Potential development of the role may include:

- Supporting the Sports Science department with GPS technology, particularly in presenting collected data to the wider tennis team.
- Delivering age group baseline statistics reports (termly) to lead coaches.
- Assisting coaches working with internationallevel players by developing scouting reports, compiling opponent data (ATP & WTA Tour), and providing analytical support.
- Carrying out additional duties as requested by the STA Team.

This placement also offers the opportunity to collect data and case studies to support your final year dissertation or university projects.




INTERNATIONAL PLACEMENT OF THE YEAR
