Looking for ways to keep their players energised, STA Directors Dan and Vicki Kiernan started hosting Instagram Lives and Zoom interviews with Pro Players. The Academy's players and parents were receiving such amazing insights, they decided to bring these chats to a wider audience...

Dan and Vicki created the CTC podcast to entertain, educate and energise the tennis community through the difficult periods of lockdowns and quarantines. Since then, the podcast has gone from strength to strength, and has now won 'Best Tennis Podcast' at the Sports Podcast Awards three years in a row!

Our guests have included pro players Sir Andy Murray, WTA World Number 1 Iga Swiatek, Holger Rune, and top coaches like Louis Cayer and the late great Nick Bolletieri.


From Grand Slam Champions to those at grass roots level, from sports journalists to backroom staff, our aim is to truly get under the bonnet of the sport that we love at all levels.

The Role

This placement includes a variety of tasks across multiple areas to support and grow the podcast.

Guest Communication & Coordination

- Identifying and inviting guests, including thought leaders, industry experts, and inspiring storytellers.
- Building and cultivating relationships within the tennis world to maintain a full pipeline of guests.
- Collaborating with the podcast host,
 Dan Kiernan, to determine the right topic for each guest.
- Keeping in touch with podcast guests and maintaining positive relationships by interacting on social media, resharing their news, and celebrating their achievements.

Content Creation & Editing

- Opportunity to edit podcast episodes for quality, flow, and clarity.
- Preparing detailed show notes after each recording.
- Transcribing episodes to create audio transcripts for the podcast website.
- Collaborating with third-party services (e.g., graphic designers) for tasks such as creating podcast cover art and other visual assets.

Marketing & Promotion

 Creating and sharing social media assets for each episode across platforms, including Instagram, Facebook, X, and YouTube.











- Growing the podcast's social media presence and developing crossover content with SotoTennis Academy's platforms.
- Formatting and sending newsletters to the CTC community.
- Organising promotional efforts, including podcast competitions and awards submissions.

Research & Strategy

- Conducting research on guests and compiling notes to brief the host prior to recordings.
- Monitoring podcast growth and developing longer-term strategies using data analytics.
- Exploring monetisation opportunities, such as exclusive CTC resources, sponsorships, or paid adverts.
- Entering CTC into podcast competitions to enhance visibility.

Events & Special Projects

- Assisting in planning and organising Control the Controllables conferences and live events.
- Managing individual projects to further podcast growth and development.

Website Maintenance

- Updating podcast information and news on the CTC website.
- Optimising SEO and maintaining an engaging online presence.

General Support

- Handling everyday tasks to keep the podcast running smoothly.
- Demonstrating flexibility to assist with other duties as needed by the SotoTennis Academy Team.




