STA's vision: to set the standards and be the benchmark for what people expect and demand from an International Tennis Academy.


STA's philosophy: we care about Player Welfare, Player Development and our Player Pathway. We look after our players from day one all the way through their journey.

The Role

This role includes but is not limited to:

Coaching

- Planning, supporting or leading daily S&C group and individual training sessions, including warm ups and cool downs
- Collaborating with tennis coaches on integrated sessions
- Monitoring players' progress
- Supporting players at local, national and potentially international tournaments
- Providing nutritional advice
- Working with players with injuries including visits to STA's physiotherapist
- Working and communicating with the wider STA team
- Assisting with the transport of players to different training locations within the Academy

Player Communications & Welfare

- Communicating with players, parents and sponsors in person and via phone/email
- Meeting and greeting new players and parents

Marketing

- Helping with content collection in S&C sessions - photos, videos, etc.
- Collaborating with STA's Marketing Team on S&C-related social media posts and assets
- Working with the Off-Court Team on exciting STA Events, including International Tournaments

Demonstrating flexibility within the job role to assist with other duties requested by the STA Team.





APPLICATION CLOSING DATE

The closing date for this placement is March 2026, however, this placement position may be offered before this date to the right candidate, so earlier applications are **strongly** encouraged.
